



Xtriage's analysis on translational NCS is as follows: The largest off-origin peak in the Patterson function is 2.66% of the height of the origin peak. No significant pseudotranslation is detected.








The following is a graphical depiction of the model fit to experimental electron density of all instances of the Ligand of Interest. In addition, ligands with molecular weight > 250 and outliers
